1 Peter 5:1-3

## 1. Try A Little T\_\_\_\_\_

“Be shepherds of God’s flock that is under your care, serving as overseers.” Vs. 2

A key word here is “w\_\_\_\_\_.”

## 3. Be The L\_\_\_\_\_, Not The L\_\_\_\_\_

“...not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.” Vs. 3
